This award recognizes graduating seniors who have earned the highest and second-highest college GPA with a minimum of 28 credit hours & have completed a career pathway by high school graduation through dual enrollment or SB2 status in CCSD for students attending Athens Community Career Academy in the Clarke County School District, Athens, Georgia.

The Taylor Family Dual Enrollment Award and will be awarded yearly by the FFE to two (2) graduating ACCA seniors at \$250 each starting Spring 2023.

The Athens Community Career Academy provides students with opportunities to learn in various *Career Pathways* in a college-like environment. Career Academy students learn technical skills from highly qualified instructors and participate in various internships and apprenticeships.
